Re: Complaints against member R. Keith Oliver and William Cadman

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated September 23, 2010.

With respect to paragraph two of your letter, there is certainly a separation on the issue at hand and I will advise you that I have a record to show my concern about the *Legal Profession in British Columbia*.

Please note the following:

1. I was called to the bar on May 16, 1957 and throughout my practice and thereafter, as a retired member, I maintain vigilance on the oath of lawyers duties responsibilities and integrity owed, *inter alia*, to the profession.
2. I have throughout the years, made complaints regarding other members of the bar who were in violation of the code of ethics prescribed for members of the profession, which amongst others, was Mr. Martin Wirick.
3. The Law Society has always shown me respect by keeping me informed and responding to all my communications. In effect, I take credit for any and all infractions pointed out to the leadership of the Law Society, which led to Mr. Wirick being criminally charged and subsequently paid the penalty with a seven (7) year jail sentence.
4. I reasonably anticipate the same respect from you and from the director of the Law Society regarding my concerns I have with two members of the bar that I know have violated the Code of Ethics of lawyers and believe that both are bringing disgrace to the Legal Profession.
5. I ask that you treat my complaints against Messrs. R. Keith Oliver and William Cadman in the same manner as my complaints against Martin Wirick, Jonathan Oldroyd, Michael Custance, and others.


