Dear Mr Jasich:

I am writing further to your letter dated 29 January 2009, in which you ask that the disposition of Mr Gaffney's complaint be reconsidered. You also ask that apologies be offered to your client, Mr Gaffney, for informing him of the disposition of his complaint as drafted by Mrs Zanetti.

The letter of Mrs Zanetti dated 12 December 2008 begins with the following sentence: "I am writing on behalf Mr Harold Gaffney, a senior citizen of 76 years of age. I assisted Mr Gaffney during court proceedings ..." Mr Gaffney's name is bolded in the letter. This explains why the response was addressed to both Mr Gaffney, the complainant, and Mrs Zanetti, his representative.

In your letter of 22 January 2009, you assert that you are Mr Gaffney's lawyer. Your letter of 29 January 2009 is a request for the reconsideration of the disposition of Mr Gaffney's complaint. As Mr Gaffney is the original complainant, Mr Gaffney will be provided with a copy of this response.

In reviewing Mr Gaffney's complaint, Chief Justice Scott found that the allegations were vexatious and made for an improper purpose and he directed that the file be closed. The material you have provided does not add any new information to the original complaint. Given Chief Justice Scott's conclusion, this file will remain close.
